What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- Name

- Other information relevant to OAB's activities.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping.
- We may use the information to improve our services.
- We may periodically send / email you about the official
 OAB Newsletters or other information which we think you

may find interesting using the email address which you have provided. This is only sent if you have consented to this.

• We may use the information to customise the website according to user's interests.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file that is placed on your computer's hard drive. The cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular page. We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used.
